2. The brother who moved to Dallas didn't live on North Street. Larry didn't move to St. Louis or Boston. The zoologist moved to a house on Brook Street.
3. The jockey didn't live in a Cape house. The Gambrel house wasn't owned by the accountant. The actor owned the Colonial house. Fred didn't live in Dallas.
4. The ranch house was owned by the Boston resident. The psychologist was Fred but he didn't live on Main Street. The brother who lived in St. Louis bought a Gambrel house.
5. Oliver didn't live in San Francisco. The actor didn't live on Main Street. The Victorian-style house was on Maple Street. George, who wasn't the jockey, didn't live in Baltimore.
6. The quintuplets were Fred, the jockey, the brother who bought a ranch house, the brother who lives in San Francisco, and the brother who lives on Maple Street.
