- 3. Denise wasn't Heidi's little sister. The girl who added pecans didn't make her fudge on Tuesday.
- 4. The first and last girls to make fudge were the girl who added walnuts and the girl whose little sister was named Brenda, respectively.
- 5. Janice made fudge two days before the girl who added almonds. Susan's sister added peanuts to her fudge.
- 6. Heidi didn't make her fudge on Wednesday but she did add almonds to it. Rhoda didn't make her fudge on Friday.
