4. The first and last girls to make fudge were the girl who added walnuts and the girl whose little sister was named Brenda, respectively.
5. Janice made fudge two days before the girl who added almonds. Susan's sister added peanuts to her fudge.
6. Heidi didn't make her fudge on Wednesday but she did add almonds to it. Rhoda didn't make her fudge on Friday.
